STUDY SKILLS

Mrs Harris' study sessions have focused on retrieving information efficiently and effectively. Students have learnt that memories are stored initially in the hippocampus and the science behind it. New memories do not last long and of the new information learnt in class on Monday morning, only 2% will be remembered by Friday. Therefore, it is vital to learn how to REVIEW new information daily and weekly by BRAIN DUMPING, retrieval methods such as MIND MAPPING and the LEITNER SYSTEM.
